
Download free music, movies, television, ebooks, audiobooks, and comic books from your computer or device and enjoy them wherever you go! *Turn this page over for instructions for your mobile device*.

If you are using a desktop or laptop computer:

Step 1: Go to www.hoopladigital.com. You can also find a link to this page on our web site: go to the **Explore** tab and click on **Ebooks**, **Eaudiobooks**, **and Downloads**. Click on **Music**, **Movies**, **and Television**.


Step 2: If it is your first visit to Hoopla, click **Get Started**. Follow the instructions to create an account – enter your email address, create a password, choose Innisfil Public Library, and enter your library card number. You

must check the box that allows Hoopla to exchange information with your library. For all future visits, simply type in your email and password at the top of the page and click Log In!



Step 3: If you have borrowed items, you'll be able to find them at the top of the page. If not, click to explore the six Hoopla collections — Audiobooks, Movies, Music, Comics, Ebooks, and Television — or use the menus at the top of the page to browse or search for something to borrow. You'll be able to borrow five items each month. Important: each episode of a television series counts as 1 borrow.

Step 5: The Borrow button turns into the Play button. Click Play to begin enjoying your item. Important: unless you use the Google Chrome web browser, you will need to install the Widevine plug-in in order to watch movies and television shows on your computer. Click Help at the bottom of the page and choose Website Help for instructions on how to install it.

Step 4: Click the cover of the item you're interested in. You will see a summary page showing you information about the item, including how long you may borrow

Step 1: Go to the App Store or Play Store and search for Hoopla Digital. Install and open the app. Click Sign Up if it is your first visit, and follow the directions. When you return to Hoopla, click Log In.





Step 2: Depending on your mobile device, there are several ways to find something new to borrow:



To Browse, tap to choose a collection or item. For Android devices the **Home** tab lets you swipe to see featured collections for the six Hoopla categories: **Movies**, Music, Ebooks, Audiobooks, Comics, and Television. Use the Borrowed, History, and Favourites menu items to find titles you've already enjoyed, or swipe to see featured items in the collection you want to search and choose Tap Here to View More.

On iPads, look for the Video, Music, and Books buttons at the bottom of the screen, or try the Genres, Recommended, Featured, and Popular buttons.

To Search, click the magnifying glass icon and type in

your search terms. Tap to select an item from the list, sorted by category.

Step 3: Tap the picture of the item you want to borrow. You will see a summary page showing you information about the item including how long you may borrow it.

Tap the word **Borrow** to add the item to your account. You can now access it from the My Titles section of the Hoopla main page. This section also tells you how many borrows you have left each month. Tap the heart icon to mark an item as a Favourite so it's easy to find again later, or **Share** to share on social media. **Important**: each episode of a television series counts as 1 borrow.

Apple devices will let you **download** or **return** directly from the **My Titles** section. If you are using an Android device, you can download your content for offline use or return it by searching for the item using the magnifying glass. You can access your

Hoopla account from any mobile device with the Hoopla app or any desktop/laptop computer with an internet connection.
